| Policy: | Should any agency lose its Medical Director due to illness, relocation, or any other unforeseen <br> events, the Chairperson of the WREMAC shall serve as acting Medical Director for up to 60 days. <br> In this situation, the WREMAC Chair will be exempt from the maximum agency and provider <br> limits set forth in NYS DOH Bureau of EMS policy 03-07 for the duration of the 60 day temporary <br> period. <br> The agency will make all necessary efforts to contract with an appropriate medical director within <br> that 60 day time period. |
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| Procedure: | Agencies are responsible for notifying the WREMAC immediately in writing upon becoming aware <br> of the actual or impending loss of their Medical Director. |
