<b>Title: Ambulance Transportation</b>	<b>Effective Date: June 28 1999</b> <b>Page: 1 of 1</b>
<b>Policy #1999-7</b>	<b>Reviewed: June 2009 without changes</b>

<b>Policy:</b>	Ambulances, which are accessed by the general public via calling 911 or other emergency numbers, are ONLY to transport patients to Article 28 facilities.
<b>Procedure:</b>	Any Article 28 facility that maintains some form of emergency services is to accept ALL ambulances brought to it.  There are to be no cases in which a facility acts to select which ambulance cases are brought to it and which it re-routes to other facilities.
