Intranasal Drug Administration

Takes or Verbalizes BSI procedures	
Completes assessment(s) and determines patient needs medication	
Calls Medical Direction for order or confirms standing order	
Lists indication of for Intranasal Narcan administration	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reversal of CNS and respiratory depression induced by narcotics 	
<u>List Contraindications:</u> * Pediatrics * Nasal Trauma * Seizure Activity	
*Cardiopulmonary Arrest * Therapeutic Opiate	
Prepare Equipment	
Check medication - clarity and expiration	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right patient 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right medication 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right dose 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right route 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right time 	
Lists the appropriate dosage for the medication 2.0 mg, repeat dose of 2.0 mg if RR < or = 10 after 5 minutes from initial dose	
Verbalize consideration of restraining the patient prior to drug administration	
Properly Administers the medication: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assembles Mucosal Atomization Device (MAD) to syringe securely • Inserts MAD into the nostril • Administers the medication in a fast push manner 	
Verbalize the need for ongoing assessments including observance the desired affects	
Verbalize the indications for an additional dose	
Voice proper documentation of medication administration	

Critical Criteria:

- ___ Use appropriate standard precautions
- ___ Ensure 5 rights of medication administration are met
- ___ Reassess patient for desired or adverse effects after medication administration
